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Moving A.I. Text To Work Doc & Personalizing Your Content.

This is the not fun part.

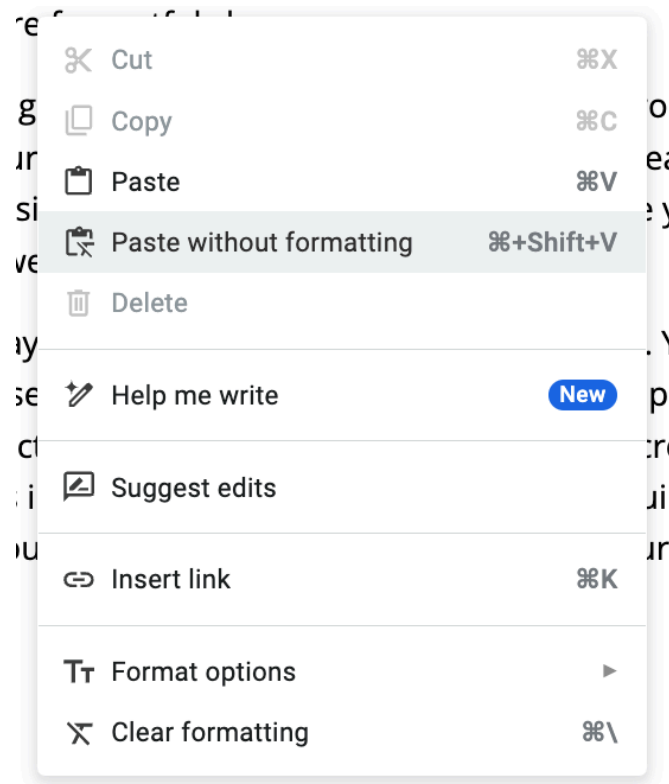
It's the part where you copy and paste everything generated by A.I. into a word document that you can turn into PDF.

Once I generate all my content with whatever A.I. tool I'm using, I like to paste everything over to a word doc.

I like Google docs but you can use whatever word processor you prefer.

You can do a regular copy and paste which will keep the formatting like chapter titles, subheads, bullets, etc.

Or you can paste without formatting by right clicking in Google Docs and selecting "Paste without formatting."



Once everything is copy & pasted, I go through and tinker with formatting and get the color and font sizes the way I want.

It's kind of tedious but if you treat it like a race you can get in the zone and move all the content over to a doc and have it formatted pretty fast.

Plugin That Creates A.I. Content Directly In Google Docs

At the moment there are no Make or Zapier integrations that automate moving content from A.I. tools to Doc tools. *(I suspect that will change in the near future.)*

But there is a plugin that lets you run A.I. directly in Google Docs using a ChatGTP or Claude API.

NOTE: The API is pay-as-you-go so your monthly ChatGTP or Claude subscription will not work with this plugin.

It's called "ChatGPT in Google Sheets and Docs" that you can find that here:

You enter your prompts in the Google Docs plugin sidebar just like you would in the ChatGTP, Claude, or Gemini workspace and it generates your output directly in Google Docs.

It's a cool plugin for high-volume content creators but as I'm writing this the plugin is still in beta. Once it's officially launched I'll create a more comprehensive training on how to use it because it saves a lot of time.

Adding A Final Human Touch

If you want to create the best possible product, which I hope you do, I suggest going through your product and giving a quick edit once you're done generating it with A.I.

I know, I know, this is all about making A.I. do the work.

Look, you won't have to spend hours editing.

I just want you to inject some of your personality into the product and maybe change a few sentences.

This prompt will create an info-product that's ready to sell without you editing anything, so this step is optional.

But as someone who's had single eBooks make 7-figures in sales, I can tell you that one high-quality eBook can change your life.

 **I want you creating high-quality 7-figure eBooks.**

Taking an extra 20-30 minutes to go through and polish your eBook so it shines like a star is worth the effort.
